### **OVERVIEW**

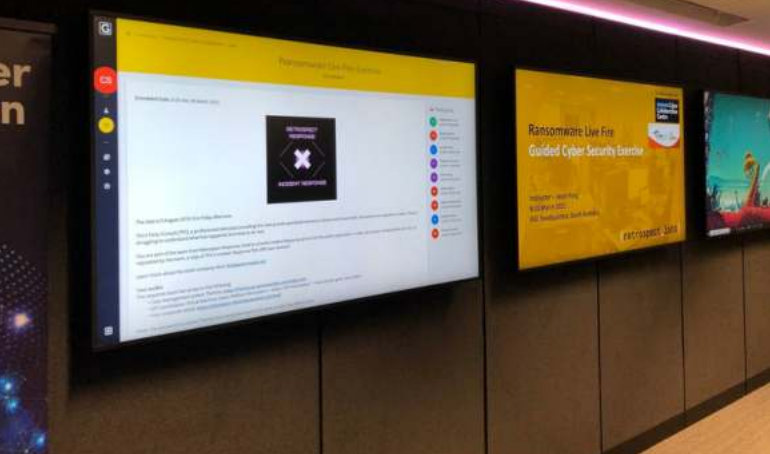

Over the course of one day, you'll work your way through a number of different scenarios, all representing different types of cyber security incidents, and all requiring you to think about how you would best respond to such an incident. You'll complete a number of different tasks for each scenario, like forensic analysis on different files and artefacts, answering questions based on your analysis, and preparing briefings for various stakeholders.

Based on the tasks you complete, we will score your submissions and a winner will be announced following completion of the event!
